1. Present

**Business from the last meeting**

3. The minutes of the previous main meeting were read by Mick Wigglesworth and agreed to be an accurate reflection of the business transacted at that meeting.
4. Glen reported on the Great North Run and the acquisition and (near) installation of the AED.
5. Glen reported that the replacement bench has now been purchased and should be installed at the same time as the AED.
6. Glen reported that funding had been secured for the proposed fencing along the Avenue.
7. Glen reported that an application had gone in to the Camping and Caravan Club for a Certificated Site on the land to the west of the former Garden Center, to which the Parish would be objecting.
8. Giles reported that Selby District Council had said that the work done at the former Garden Center was sufficient to constitute the start of development for the purposes of planning permission, and the pre-conditions to development had been complied with.

9. Glen reported that the worst of the overhanging branches had been dealt with.
10. Glen reported that the majority of streetlights had been dealt with – at the time of the meeting there were issues with two at the west end of the village, and one outside Westfield Farm which had no electricity supply.

**New business**

11. It was proposed that we hold the annual tidy day at some stage prior to the end of the year and include the area at the west end of the village – around and behind the new bench – in the area to be tidied this year.
12. The wildflower plans for 2017 were discussed, and it was agreed that we should scale it back to a more manageable area initially, on the south side of Main Street opposite the play park, and scale up from there if things worked a little better.
13. Santa’s visit is planned for Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> (after the Christingle Service). It was agreed that a similar format to last year be implemented.
14. Barry raised a concern about trees on River Lane adversely impacting on his property, and it was agreed that he would email details to Giles to look into.
15. Glen raised a couple of recent issues in the village that raised the question of whether CCTV would be beneficial. It was agreed that at this stage we would look into the licensing, practicality and likely cost.

There being no other business, the meeting closed at 9.05pm, with the date and time of the next meeting to be arranged.
