Matters Arising From Previous Meeting

1. Post Office Lane - The forms to designate the status of the lane had been completed and sent to NYCC at Fulford. As yet no reply had been received. This was to be followed up.
2. Planning Application for Mr W Wright - Mr Burrows had visited the site on 3.9.91 and had noted in his site visit report that there were 'lots of trees' on the proposed site. He was unavailable for comment on the 11.9.91 but Mr Forrester of Selby Council advised the Parish Meeting to instigate a Tree Preservation Order on the site and a letter was to be sent voicing concern over the trees and the accesses to the proposed development. A letter was also to be sent to the Highways Planning Department at NYCC Northallerton regarding the proposed accesses. Mr B Metcalf also requested a copy of the letter to be sent to Selby Council Planning.
3. Cleaning of Dykes - there were none at the present time felt to be in need of cleaning. Due to the lack of rain.

Item 1

Outline Application for the erection of a Village Farm Shop and Store with Living Accommodation and Car Parking Facilities on 0.2 Ha of Land at Sandfield, West Haddlesey for Mr T C Askin.

There were no objections to the proposed development and it was felt in the meeting that the proposed development would be a benefit to the village.

Any Other Business

1. Fire in West Haddlesey on 23.8.91. Concern was raised over the fact that the water pressure in the village was so low that the fire engine had to suck the water to extinguish the fire from the river. The delay in reaching the fire of approximately 30 minutes and the attitude of the Emergency Service that 'You only said it was a caravan' - these points were to be brought to the attention of the Regional Fire Service in a letter asking for an explanation and hopefully a solution. A letter was also to be written to Yorkshire Water in Wakefield regarding the low pressure in the village.

2. Speeding through the village - Mr B Metcalf mentioned various 'Speed Calming' methods but really said there was no solution to the problem of Speeding Cars in the village.
