Planning application for a proposed change of ground floor room to nursery School at Willow Farm, West Haddlesey.

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Item 2

Proposed conversion of existing shop to a tea room at West Haddlesey Herb & Heather Centre, Stone-Lea-Grange.

It was noted that the Parish Meeting was unaware that planning for a shop had been passed, the wooden hut could also constitute a fire risk, also does the existing shop and proposed tearoom conform to Health & Safety and Environmental Health Standards.

Parking Space was also mentioned, there is no parking space for coaches.

Item 3

Proposed planning application for erection of a Single Residential Unit at Westfield Farm, by Mr R Pool.

It was noted that the proposed site was not in the village plan. The need for more information on the proposed 'Unit' was expressed.

Item 4

The footpath at the end of the village outside the development of 'Christopher George' has been complained about, also outside 7 The Avenue the water is standing on the pavement due to the modification to the drive of 6 The Avenue.

A question was raised about the sale of Davidsons' Fold Yard, was there planning permission granted on the site or not?
