MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING.

1. A letter has been received back from North Yorkshire County Council regarding seating of children on school buses. The practice of three children to two seats is to be phased out.
2. It has been noted that within two days of the last meeting the overgrown hedges and grass verges had been trimmed back.
3. A reply has been received from North Yorkshire Police saying that they noted problem of speeding motorcycles through the village. To date there had been 10 offences committed but they would continue to monitor the situation.

ITEM NO. 1

Request by Mr Denton of Aire View to erect a street light on River Lane to be funded by himself - No objections.

ITEM NO.2

A letter has been received from the Chairman of Selby District Council asking for a donation towards his charity appeal. We are to politely refuse due to our commitments.

ITEM NO.3

A letter has been received from Selby District Council re dyke cleaning. A survey of the dyke that runs between the George & Dragon pub and the canal is to take place but there are no plans to culvert it due to finance. They have no record of the dyke that runs on the northern side of the village between Gateforth road and the canal.

ITEM NO. 4

The clerk attended a meeting on 30.6.94 about the proposed conveyer belt that will run between Gascoigne Wood and Eggborough Power Station. Not much information is forthcoming but more will become available later in the Autumn.
