### Purpose of meeting

- 1) Heavy goods transport through the village and narrow lanes, there are already far too many speeding through causing damage to properties.
- 2) No mention of weighbridge on new site, this would mean making 2 journeys everytime from new site to old site with every load.
- 3) Dwelling - Mr. Askin lives at Malt Kiln Manor not Malt Kiln farm.
- 4) When was positive planning approval granted for residential developments on Malt Kiln farm as stated in ADAS leaflet.
- 5) What will happen to the old buildings at malt kiln farm when Mr. Askin relocates.
- 6) Where will slurry from the bullocks run to.
- 7) No mention in ADAS report about mushroom compost which he is already bagging and sending out in bulk in large H.G.V.s

In conclusion this is a big new development which will bring more disadvantages to the village such as more heavy traffic, smells and dust and we feel this would be yet another eyesore.
