1. **Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

3. **Playing Field**

The proposal of a playing field situated in West Haddlesey was discussed, all those present agreed in principal that a playing field would be beneficial to West Haddlesey, enabling the children to have a 'safe' play area.

Lottery Grant

Fencing/Gate

Mr. Glynne-Walton suggested that the play area should fenced off with a gate in order that children would not be able run out on to the road.

Seating

Seating would be provided and a suggestion was made by Christine Andrews that these could be 'commemorative', and be sponsored by individuals.

Maintenance

Audrey Smith raised the subject of the cost of general maintenance - this would be looked into.

Insurance

Mike Wetherell raised the subject of insurance which Christine Andrews would obtain details.

4. **Traffic Control**

Audrey reported on a Highways meeting held in Hambleton, which she was unable to attend but read out the issues concerning West Haddlesey.

Mr. and Mrs Camfield intend to write a letter regarding speeding traffic in the village for approval at the next Parish meeting.

Mr. Camfield mentioned that the pole situated adjacent to his property will be removed and stored on his land for security.
