3. Minutes of the last Meeting dated 25 January 2000

4. Matters Arising from Minutes

4.1. Street Lights

The Chairman reported that all the street lights were now all complete and working.

4.2. Siting of Waste Water Treatment Plant

The Clerk reported that a letter had been sent to Yorkshire Water.

5. Proposed Playing Field/Playground

The Chairman reported on progress. A bank account had been set up and a solicitor appointed. Insurance and grants were being investigated. Raffles were to be held and donations for prizes were being sought.

6. Yorkshire Water Planning Application for Waste Water Treatment Plant

A presentation was given by Alan Woodhouse on behalf of Yorkshire Water regarding the proposals for the siting of the plant. He explained that because of the topography of the village, the plant needed to be centrally located.

A long and detailed discussion followed regarding the siting of the plant and the general consensus of the meeting was that the proposed position was not acceptable and that an alternative should be investigated. Cow Flat Lane was suggested because a plot of land had been purchased by Selby District Council for sewage treatment some years earlier down Cow Flat Lane. It was also recommended that all properties should be connected to the new system at the time of installation rather than only the ones currently connected to the public sewers.

It was agreed the Chairman should write to the Planning Authority at North Yorkshire stating the objections raised at the meeting.
