

West Haddlesey Parish Meeting
Oct 4th 2000

Apologies – Roger Denton

Minutes of last meeting – Proposed - Graham Craft
Seconds – Liz Wetherell

Planning Application – For three houses adjacent to Laburnam house.

No objections – but it was pointed out that there was a Yorkshire and Northumbria bylaw (Env agency) that requires 5m from the landward side of the bottom of the flood bank, which would effect the positioning of the proposed dwellings.

Matters arising from previous meeting

Village notice board

It was agreed that the new notice board would be sited at the post office, which has been approved by Judy – and to ask Mr Brunyard if he would erect it even if it involved extra cost.

New village signs

This matter still in the process of costing.

Speeding through the village

Points brought up

1. To approach British waterways regarding weight limit on the canal bridge.
2. Extending the 30 mph limit from the Chapel Haddlesey to the west end of the avenue (West Haddlesey) which will incorporate the proposed children's playing field.

Trees in the avenue

Mike Harrison of S.D.C will be contacted as soon as Elizabeth and Ian have agreed on how many and the type of trees required.

Street lighting

It was agreed that extra lighting was required in the village.

1. One adjacent to the post office this would provide lighting for the post box and notice board (Judy has no objection).
2. It was felt that the avenue of trees was another area where lighting was required.
3. A villager requested that he would like the light removed from outside his home (no 8 the Avenue) and be repositioned in the avenue of trees, or if anything could be done to shield the light from his bedroom window.

Sewage system

After much discussion the meeting agreed that Yorkshire water had changed plans repeatedly and people had been misinformed regarding costing. It was felt Yorkshire Water/Montgomery-Watson should be approached again and a 'Judicial Review' taken over validity of the change of plans. Mr Cuttingham would report back to the Chairperson with details on how & if this is could be implemented.

Plastic bags

Concern was expressed about the no of plastic bags blowing about the fields and especially down Cow Flatt Lane. Christine said she would approach Mr Askin on the matter.

Playing field

Only report at the moment is that the grass will be sown in the spring.

Footpaths

S.D.C To be informed on the encroachment of grass at the canal end of the footpath also a low spot of tarmac outside no 6 + 7 the Avenue, which holds water.
