Minutes of the Meeting held at the George and Dragon Public House, West Haddlesey on Tuesday 20 February 2001

1. Apologies for Absence

There were no apologies for absence.

2. Minutes of the last Meeting dated 4 October 2000

The Minutes of the last Meeting dated 4 October 2000 were read and agreed as being a true record.

3. Matters Arising from Minutes

3.1. Village Notice Board

The notice board was now installed and in use.

3.2. Trees for The Avenue

The trees had been delivered and Mike Weatherall asked for volunteers for planting.

3.3. Street Lights

It was reported that a scheme had been designed for four street lights in The Avenue. The existing street light outside No. 8 The Avenue had been shielded as requested.

The Chairman reported that grants were still available for Crime Prevention projects.

3.4. Plastic Bags

The Chairman reported that she had asked Mr Askin if he would deal with the plastic bags.

3.5. Footpaths

The Chairman reported that the unsatisfactory footpaths had been reported and were awaiting reinstatement by Yorkshire Electricity.

4. Election of Chairman and Secretary

Christine Andrews was re-elected as Chairman and Roger Denton was re-elected as Secretary.

5. Financial Accounts Statement

The Secretary reported on the financial accounts for the year ended 31 March 2000.

It was estimated that the annual expenditure for the coming year could be in the region of £900/1000 and a precept of £1000 had been requested from Selby District Council.

It was agreed to approach Eggborough Power Station for a Landfill Tax Credit grant for the provision of village signs.

6. Proposed Erection of Two Houses on Land off Field Lane

The plans were studied for the two properties and it was agreed that the only point of concern was their proximity to the road. The Secretary was asked to raise the issue of sufficient off-road turning areas for vehicles in his reply to Selby District Council.

7. Yorkshire Water Waste Water Installation

The Chairman reported that she had been informed by the contractor that all work in the road would be complete by the end of March.

It had been decided that a judicial review would be too costly to pursue.

Reinstatement of the road and verges was a concern and it was agreed to liaise with the Highways Authority.

8. Any Other Business

8.1. Mining

The issue of mining from Kellingley was raised. The Secretary reported that he had studied the plans about two years ago and they did not indicate any mining under the river.

8.2. Unauthorised Tipping

It was reported that some unauthorised tipping had taken place down Marsh Lane.
