Matters Arising From Previous Meeting

1. A quote from D W lighting had been received - it was a 4-year contract, £97.92 per annum, 2 visits per annum, a call-out charge of £88.50 and out of hours £177.00. This was considered far too expensive.

Another letter had been received from a Mr G Brooksbank from Hensall who would charge £6.00 per lamp plus parts.

It was decided for Derek Rollinson to contact Mr G Brooksbank.

2. The street-light opposite Low Farm was noted still to be out of order.

Detailed Plans for 3 Detached Dwellings for Mr N Naylor at Airebank House

Points Raised:-

- (a) The sewage system is indicated on the plans as running into an open drain - where a septic tank should be installed.
- (b) The access now is leading to 4 houses where planning initially allowed for 3.
- (c) A previous application in the village for a render and wood finished house was turned down.
