Matters Arising from Previous Meeting

1. The leaflets are now to be distributed at the discretion of B Bowskill and P Woodhead.
2. A Letter was received from Mr Cragg of the Environmental Health at Selby Council offering assisting in cleaning any dykes which the Parish Meeting felt were in need.
3. Post Office Lane - John Adams at NYCC at Fulford was contacted and had sent the relevant forms to the Parish Meeting which were to be completed and returned to designate the status of the lane.
4. Another letter was received from Dr S C Smeed and Partners regarding proposed dispensary at Monk Fryston - stating they will not prejudice any existing pharmacutrical or provison of general medical services in the area.

1. Proposed Erection of 2 Detched Houses on land at Haddlesey House for Mr W Wright.

It was decided to contact Mr Burrows at Selby Council Planning Office to arrange for a site visit to discuss the plans which the Parish Meeting felt were distortionate regarding trees already existing and other properties which were to be affected by the development.

2. Triennial Audit

The points raised at the Audit held at Selby Council Offices on 26.7.91 were:-

1. VAT if over £10.00 per year can now be claimed back maybe up to a period of 6 years past. The clerk was to write to VAT at Southend-On-Sea.
2. Insurance was to be investigated for 3rd Party ie: Street Light falling on someone and clerks fidelity.
3. From date of Audit the minutes are now to include financial information ie: Invoices received, payments for services authorised, monies received.

Financial Information

Invoices received from G Brooksbank - Electrician £57.75, Audit Commission £46.41 and YEB for Street Lighting £17.27 - for April to July.

These invoices were authorised for payment.
