## HOLIDAY PARK UPDATE

The latest application for the Holiday Park at the former Yorkshire Garden World came before Selby District Council's planning committee earlier this month, and Giles and Glen attended on behalf of the Parish, with Giles speaking against the application.

Whilst the planning officer's recommendation was to approve the application, the actual decision was deferred because the applicant hadn't provided a final report on the presence or absence on the site of Great Crested Newts. This has since been provided, and the matter will come back in front of the planning committee at the next meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> July at 4.00.

We would ask those residents who are opposed to the application to make the effort to attend to show their opposition. We will also be holding a short meeting in the **George and Dragon** on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July at 8.00pm** with more information on what happened at the meeting and what residents can do even at this late stage to try and ensure that the application is rejected.
